Former Governmental Accounting Standards Board Staff, Jialan Su, Joins Oxnard's Finance Department as Assistant Chief Financial Officer & Assistant City Treasurer

OXNARD, Calif. – The City of Oxnard announced the appointment of Jialan Su as the Finance Department's new Assistant Chief Financial Officer (ACFO). In her new role, Su will also serve as the Assistant City Treasurer.

Su, who joined the City in January 2025, is a certified public accountant (CPA) tasked with overseeing the City's Billing and Licensing Division. Her extensive background in governmental accounting, financial reporting, and audit management brings a wealth of experience to this critical role within the City's Finance Department.



"Ms. Su's extensive expertise in governmental accounting standards and financial oversight is an asset to Oxnard as we continue to add experienced professionals to our City's financial team," said City Manager Alexander Nguyen.

Su joined the City of Oxnard after more than a decade of experience at the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB), where she served as a Supervising Project Manager. During her tenure, she led multi-year accounting standard-setting projects including projects addressing debt and retirement obligations and external investment pools. She played a key role in post-implementation reviews of GASB pension standards, and provided guidance on technical accounting issues. Her expertise in financial reporting and policy implementation will advance improvements in transparency and efficiency within the City's financial operations.

Prior to her work at GASB, Su held audit management positions at CohnReznick LLP in New York and Brown Armstrong Accountancy Corporation in California. In these roles, she oversaw audit teams, advised CFOs and financial officers, and developed strategic financial policies for governments and nonprofit entities.

Su holds a Master of Arts in Economics from California State University, East Bay, and a Bachelor of Economics from Sichuan University in China. She is a licensed Certified Public Accountant in both California and New York and a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA).

As the City's ACFO and Assistant City Treasurer, Su oversees billing and licensing operations, ensures compliance with financial regulations, and will implement best practices to streamline processes and improve service delivery for Oxnard community members.
