

City of Oxnard Regional Consolidated Plan Amendment

Section V Strategic Plan

Overview

In March of 2024, the City of Oxnard began the planning process to target current and future resources to address the priority needs within the Regional Consolidated Plan with emphasis on two communities within its jurisdiction – La Colonia and Central Oxnard. All six goals identified on page 161 in the current 2020-2024 Regional Consolidated Plan will remain unchanged.

Geographic Priorities

The City of Oxnard is amending this section (on pages 162-163) to add Central Oxnard and La Colonia as targeted neighborhoods to focus future allocations in. The number of residents within the area according to the 2010 Census estimated 18,816, with an 33.33 % average of low-income residents within this area.

Anticipated Resources

The City will continue to use the listed source of funds identified on page 182, and is seeking a Choice Neighborhood Implementation (CNI) grant for the proposed target neighborhoods. The CNI grant awards proposed are as follows:
