

Below is the weekly remote sensor data from 4/22/21 to 4/28/21. Acceptable dissolved oxygen concentrations (DO; in blue) and generally low concentrations of chlorophyll with normal daily oscillations (chlorophyll is a proxy for microscopic algal biomass, in green) were observed at both stations. The brief spikes in chlorophyll concentration observed at station 6 (Seabridge) may be due to interference from boat traffic or floating macroalgae.

The City of Oxnard and Aquatic Bioassay & Consulting will continue to monitor the sensors in the area.
