RESOLUTION NO. 11,071

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD ORDERING THE FORMATION OF AND LEVY OF ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1996-97 WITHIN LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 23 PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972.

WHEREAS, on May 21, 1996, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 11,061, declaring its intention to form Landscape Maintenance District No. 23 (Greystone) and levy and collect assessments for the 1996-97 fiscal year within the district in order to pay the costs of maintaining landscaping therein; and

WHEREAS, a description of the improvements and the proposed assessment upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the District is contained in the report of the Engineer, dated May 1996, on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 11,061set a hearing for June 18, 1996, on the levy of the proposed assessment, which was held and all interested persons were afforded the opportunity to hear and be heard; and

WHEREAS, City Council considered the oral statements and all written protests made or filed by any interested person; and

WHEREAS, a majority protest to the formation of the District was not filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oxnard resolves:

- 1. Landscape Maintenance District No. 23 is ordered formed and the improvements and the assessment proposed in the report of the Engineer, and its accompanying diagram, on file with the City Clerk are confirmed.
- 2. The adoption of this resolution shall constitute the levy of an assessment for the 1996-97 fiscal year within Landscape Maintenance District No. 23.
- 3. The City Clerk shall immediately file the diagram and assessment, or a certified copy thereof, with the Ventura County Auditor.
