

The California Coastal Act requires local governments to prepare and implement Local Coastal Programs (LCPs) to protect natural and man-made coastal resources and provide public access to the shoreline. Climate change risks that affect these characteristics, as the sea level rises and severe storms become more frequent, threaten coastal resources and communities.

The City is seeking community input and feedback to help draft an updated LCP that supports the community's vision for the future, addresses specific coastal hazard risks, and aligns with the Coastal Act.



What is the Coastal Act?

The California Coastal Act (1976) regulates development within the state's coastal zone. The Act is implemented by the California Coastal Commission.

What is a Local Coastal Program?


¿Por qué se necesita un Actualización del Programa Costero Local?

The California Coastal Act requires all cities and counties to adopt their own Local Coastal Program (LCP) that's specific to local conditions and priorities.

Once the California Coastal Commission certifies an LCP, a city gains permitting authority.


La Ley de Costas de California exige que todas las ciudades y condados adopten su propio Programa Costero Local que sea específico para las condiciones y prioridades locales.

Una vez que la Comisión Costera de California certifica un Programa Costero Local, la ciudad obtiene la autoridad para otorgar permisos.


Local Coastal Program have two parts:

- The Land Use Plan describes types of land uses and their locations, and includes resource protection and development policies
- The Local Implementation Plan includes the zoning ordinance and maps, and gives more details on the policies of the LUP

Programa Costero Locales tienen dos partes:

- El Plan de Uso de la Tierra describe los tipos de usos de la tierra y sus ubicaciones, e incluye pólizas de desarrollo y protección de recursos.
- El Plan de Implementación Local incluye la ordenanza de zonificación y mapas, y brinda más detalles sobre las pólizas del LUP.

What areas are covered by the Local Coastal Program? ¿Qué áreas cubre el Programa Costero Local?



There are four coastal planning areas / Hay cuatro áreas de planificación costera:

- McGrath/Mandalay Beach
- Oxnard Shores
- Channel Islands
- Ormond Beach

Why is the LCP being updated now?

¿Por qué sucede esto ahora?

Oxnard's Local Coastal Program was first certified in 1982 and has been updated several times since then. New state legislation requires that LCP's plan for impacts from sea level rise, and it's crucial for protecting public welfare and coastal resources.

El Programa Costero Local de Oxnard fue certificado por primera vez en 1982 y se ha actualizado varias veces desde entonces. La nueva legislación estatal requiere que el plan de LCP para los impactos del aumento del nivel del mar, y es crucial para proteger el bienestar público y los recursos costeros.



What does this update mean for the community? ¿Qué significa esta actualización para la comunidad?

This project will help determine how Oxnard adapts to impacts of sea level rise for many years to come. Land uses, infrastructure, and environmental resources will be regulated by sea level rise planning policies in order to increase community resilience.

Este proyecto ayudará a determinar cómo Oxnard se adapta a los impactos del aumento del nivel del mar durante muchos años. Los usos de la tierra, la infraestructura y los recursos ambientales estarán regulados por las políticas de planificación del aumento del nivel del mar con el fin de aumentar la resiliencia de la comunidad.



What is being studied and updated?

¿Qué se está estudiando y actualizando?


We are studying sea level rise and its potential impacts on the community. Sea level rise affects flooding, coastal storms, erosion, wave action, etc. We will first determine what areas and resources are most at risk, and then create adaptation options to reduce those risks. Those adaptation options will be evaluated for cost and turned into policies.

Estamos estudiando el aumento del nivel del mar y sus posibles impactos en la comunidad. El aumento del nivel del mar afecta las inundaciones, las tormentas costeras, la erosión, la acción de las olas, etc. Primero determinaremos qué áreas y recursos están en mayor riesgo y luego crearemos opciones de adaptación para reducir esos riesgos. Esas opciones de adaptación se evaluarán en función de su costo y se convertirán en pólizas.



What is being studied and updated?

How is sea level rise being addressed, and how does it relate to overall climate adaptation? / ¿Cómo se aborda el aumento del nivel del mar y cómo se relaciona con la adaptación climática general?

Based on Oxnard's particular vulnerabilities, we will find adaptation strategies that increase resilience – potential options include monitoring, permitting standards, flood hazard abatement, nature-based enhancements, hard engineering structures, development design modifications, and hybrids that combine multiple adaptation approaches.

Sea level rise one component of climate change. Oxnard already has a Climate Action and Adaptation Plan that will be supported by this project.

Sobre la base de las vulnerabilidades particulares de Oxnard, encontraremos estrategias de adaptación que aumentan la resiliencia: Las opciones potenciales incluyen monitoreo, estándares de permisos, reducción de riesgos de inundación, mejoras basadas en la naturaleza, estructuras de ingeniería dura, etc. desarrollo de modificaciones de diseño, e híbridos que combinan múltiples enfoques de adaptación.

El aumento del nivel del mar es un componente del cambio climático. Oxnard ya cuenta con un Plan de Acción Climática y Adaptación que contará con el apoyo de este proyecto.

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
